	Visit the statues of King Sejong and Admiral Yi Sun Shin at <b>Gwanghwamun</b> <b>Square</b> , and get a spectacular view of <b>Gyeongbokgung Palace</b> entrance. Visit the palace and <b>National Folklore Museum</b> .		
	Then transfer to <b>Bukchon Hanok Village</b> , once the homes of Joseon Dynasty aristocrats. Continue on your way to <b>Insadong Street</b> , the historical and cultural heart of Seoul.		
	After lunch, transfer to <b>Namdaemun Market</b> , one of the largest traditional markets.		
	Then, walk through the shopping district of <b>Myeongdong</b> before going to <b>N</b> Seoul Tower.

	Upon arrival at Andong, visit <b>Hahoe Village (UNESCO Site)</b> , famous for its traditional houses and home of the descendants of the Ryu clan. Then stop at <b>Buyongdae Cliff</b> which offers a panoramic view of the village.		
	Visit Mask Museum and then check-in at the hotel.

0	After breakfast, transfer to <b>Haeinsa Temple.</b>	Gyeongju Kolon 3*	(B/L/-)
SUN	Visit <b>Haeinsa Temple (UNESCO Site)</b> , one of the three major temples of the country. At the temple, you will be able to observe «Tripitaka Koreana », a holy Buddhist writing engraved on more than 80,000 wooden boards in order to invoke the protection of Buddha from Mongolian invasions.	,	
	After lunch, drive to Daegu and visit the <b>local herbal market</b> and the <b>Museum of Oriental Medicine.</b>		
	Then transfer to Gyeongju.

	Overnight at Gyeongju (1)

7 MON	After breakfast, depart for <b>Bulguksa Temple (UNESCO Site).</b> The temple is the greatest symbol of the Shilla Dynasty becuase it embodies the mystery, beauty, and spirit of Buddhism under Shilla.	Gyeongju Kolon 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
	Then head to <b>Seokguram Grotto (UNESCO Site)</b> where the centerpeice of the granite sanctuary is a Buddha statue seated in the main chamber. It is considered one of the greatest masterpieces of the Shilla Dynasty in the 8th century.		
	After lunch, visit <b>Cheomseongdae Observatory</b> , the oldest astonomical observatory in Asia. Then walk through <b>Tumuli Park</b> where you can observe the great ancient tombs of royals and officials of the Shilla Dynasty.		
	Next, discover numerous historical and cultural artifacts of the Shilla Dynasty at <b>Gyeongju National Museum.</b>		
	Lastly, take a stroll at <b>Anapji Pond.</b>		
	Transfer to hotel.

8 TUES	After breakfast, transfer to <b>Busan</b> passing by <b>Tongdosa Temple</b> , often called « The Temple without a Buddha » since statues of the Buddha cannot be found outdoors. Next, visit <b>Busan Museum</b> to learn the important historical and cultural heritage of Busan. Then, check out Korea's largest seafood market, <b>Jagalchi</b> <b>Market</b> and continue on to <b>Gukje International Market</b> and <b>Nampodong</b> <b>District</b> , where Busan International Film Festival is held each year. 9 WED	<ul> <li>After breakfast, visit Gamcheon Cultural Village, which is formed by houses built in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain.</li> <li>Then, visit Taejongdae Park to see its impressive cliffs.</li> <li>After lunch, visit UN Cemetery and continue to Haeundae Beach to visit Nurimaru APEC House, located on Dongbaekseom Island. Admire the scenery at The APEC House, which is a pavilion built in a traditional Korean style.</li> <li>Afterwards, take the KTX bullet train back up to Seoul.
