1 TUES	<p>Arrival at Incheon Airport</p> <p>Transfer to hotel on own</p> <p><i>Rest of the day at leisure</i></p> <p>Overnight at Seoul (1)</p>	Venue G Hotel 3* or similar	(-/-/-)

2 WED	<p>Breakfast at hotel</p> <p>Meet with your guide at hotel lobby</p> <p>Full day sightseeing by public transportation</p> <p>Visit the statues of King Sejong and Admiral Yi Sun Shin at Gwanghwamun Square, and get a spectacular view of Gyeongbokgung Palace entrance. Visit the palace and National Folklore Museum.</p> <p>Then transfer to Bukchon Hanok Village, once the homes of Joseon Dynasty aristocrats. Continue on your way to Insadong Street, the historical and cultural heart of Seoul.</p> <p>After lunch, transfer to Namdaemun Market, one of the largest traditional markets.</p> <p>Then, walk through the shopping district of Myeongdong before going to N Seoul Tower.</p> <p>Return to hotel</p> <p>Dinner on own</p> <p><i>OPTIONAL: Korean House for an additional USD 65.00pp</i></p> <p>Overnight at Seoul (2)</p>	Venue G Hotel 3* or similar	(B/L/-)

3 THUR	<p>After breakfast, transfer to Goseong Unification Observatory for a glimpse of North Korea.</p> <p>Then continue to Mount Seorak National Park. You will take the cable car (if weather permits) to reach the summit and Gwongeumseong Fortress.</p> <p>Once you come down, visit Sinheungsa Temple located at the foot of Mount Seorak.</p> <p>Dinner on own</p> <p>Overnight at Seorak (1)</p>	Sokcho The Class 300 hotel 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
SEORAK – GANGNEUNG - CHUNGJU			
4 FRI	<p>After breakfast, transfer to Gangneung and stop at Ojukheon House, one of the remaining oldest wooden residential building of Korea.</p> <p>Then, visit Woljeongsa Temple, one of the most beautiful temples in Korea.</p> <p>Transfer to Chungju toride a small ferry at Lake Chungju to enjoy the scenery.</p> <p>Dinner on own</p> <p>Overnight at Chungju (1)</p>	Cheongpun g Resort 3* or similar	(B/L/-)

CHUNGJU - ANDONG			
5	After breakfast, head to Andong .	Andong Park 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
SAT	On the way, visit DosanSeowon Confucian School established in 1574. Then have lunch at a local restaurant		
	Upon arrival at Andong, visit Hahoe Village (UNESCO Site) , famous for its traditional houses and home of the descendants of the Ryu clan. Then stop at Buyongdae Cliff which offers a panoramic view of the village.		
	Visit Mask Museum and then check-in at the hotel.		
	Dinner on own Overnight at Andong (1)		
ANDONG - HAEINSA			
6	After breakfast, transfer to Haeinsa Temple .	GyeongjuKolon 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
SUN	Visit Haeinsa Temple (UNESCO Site) , one of the three major temples of the country. At the temple, you will be able to observe «Tripitaka Koreana », a holy Buddhist writing engraved on more than 80,000 wooden boards in order to invoke the protection of Buddha from Mongolian invasions.		
	After lunch, drive to Daegu and visit the local herbal market and the Museum of Oriental Medicine .		
	Then transfer to Gyeongju.		
	Dinner on own Overnight at Gyeongju (1)		
GYEONGJU			
7	After breakfast, depart for Bulguksa Temple (UNESCO Site) . The temple is the greatest symbol of the Shilla Dynasty because it embodies the mystery, beauty, and spirit of Buddhism under Shilla.	GyeongjuKolon 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
MON	Then head to Seokguram Grotto (UNESCO Site) where the center piece of the granite sanctuary is a Buddha statue seated in the main chamber. It is considered one of the greatest masterpieces of the Shilla Dynasty in the 8th century.		
	After lunch, visit Cheomseongdae Observatory , the oldest astronomical observatory in Asia. Then walk through Tumuli Park where you can observe the great ancient tombs of royals and officials of the Shilla Dynasty.		
	Next, discover numerous historical and cultural artifacts of the Shilla Dynasty at Gyeongju National Museum .		
	Lastly, take a stroll at Anapji Pond . Transfer to hotel. Overnight at Gyeongju (2)

8	After breakfast, transfer to Busan passing by Tongdosa Temple , often called « The Temple without a Buddha » since statues of the Buddha cannot be found outdoors.	Busan Tower Hill 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
TUES	Next, visit Busan Museum to learn the important historical and cultural heritage of Busan. Then, check out Korea's largest seafood market, Jagalchi Market and continue on to Gukje International Market and Nampodong District , where Busan International Film Festival is held each year.

9 WED	<p>After breakfast, visit Gamcheon Cultural Village, which is formed by houses built in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain.</p> <p>Then, visit Taejongdae Park to see its impressive cliffs.</p> <p>After lunch, visit UN Cemetery and continue to Haeundae Beach to visit Nurimaru APEC House, located on Dongbaekseom Island. Admire the scenery at The APEC House, which is a pavilion built in a traditional Korean style.</p> <p>Afterwards, take the KTX bullet train back up to Seoul. Transfer to hotel</p> <p>Dinner on own</p> <p>Overnight at Seoul (3)</p>	Venue G Hotel 3* or similar	(B/L/-)
