	Then head to <b>Seokguram Grotto (UNESCO Site)</b> where the center piece of the granite sanctuary is a Buddha statue seated in the main chamber. It is considered one of the greatest masterpieces of the Shilla Dynasty in the 8th century.					
	After lunch, visit <b>Cheomseongdae Observatory</b> , the oldest astonomical observatory in Asia. Then walk through <b>Tumuli Park</b> where you can observe the great ancient tombs of royals and officials of the Shilla Dynasty.					
	Next, discover numerous historical and cultural artifacts of the Shilla Dynasty at <b>Gyeongju National Museum.</b>					
	Lastly, take a stroll at <b>Anapji Pond.</b>					
	Transfer to hotel.
